"Tell Naaman to wash himself seven times in the Jordan River, and he will be healed."



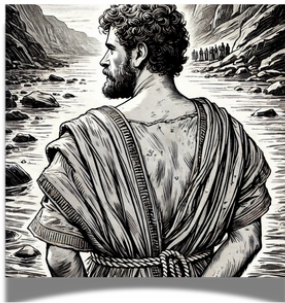

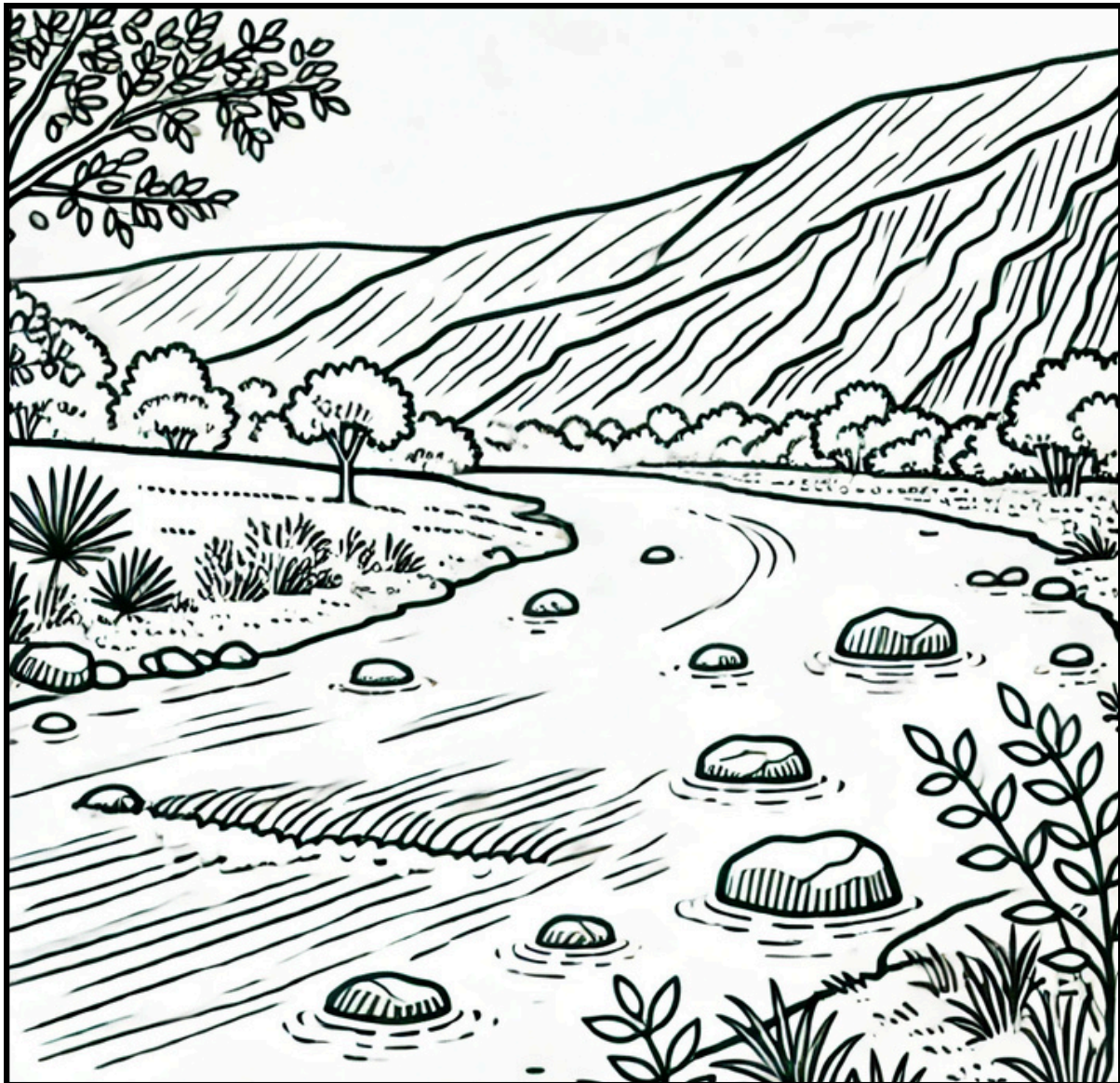

Color the river and the landscape, then draw Naaman bathing in the water. Add any extra details you like, such as rocks, waves, or people watching!

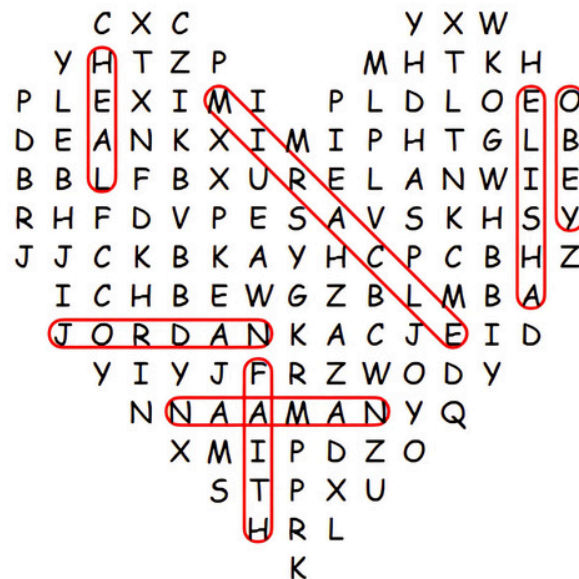
